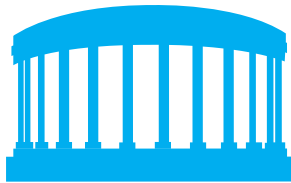

Welcome to Liverpool Central Library & Archive

Read: good books to take on holiday, to discuss in a reading group, to read on the bus or train or simply to take yourself away from everyday life.

Discover: fully accessible, new children's library with a special area for under 5's. An imaginative environment for children of all ages.

Imagine: feature films and television programmes on DVD. CDs covering all genres of music.

Game: you can play computer games on Xbox 360 or use the pcs.

Enquire is where you will find most of the library's books for loan and reference. Specialist books are shelved in the stunning Picton Reading Room, the perfect space for some quiet study. You will find 60 public computers on the 1st Floor.

The **Business and Intellectual Property Centre** on the 1st Floor has free access to industry standard resources to help you start, run and grow your business.

The magnificent **Hornby Library** houses the superb collection of Hugh Frederick Hornby and has a programme of changing exhibitions.

The **Oak Room** houses the library's rare books and always has one volume of the impressive "Birds of America" by John James Audubon on display.

Archive: access the City's extensive archives dating from the 13th century plus discover the history of your family, house, street or district.

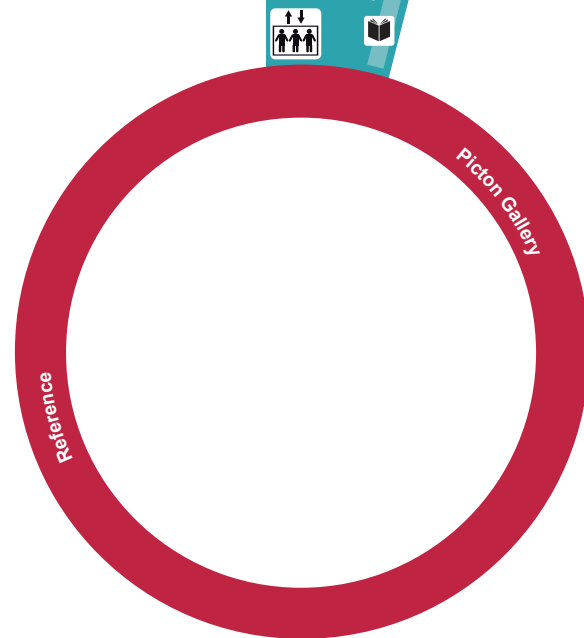
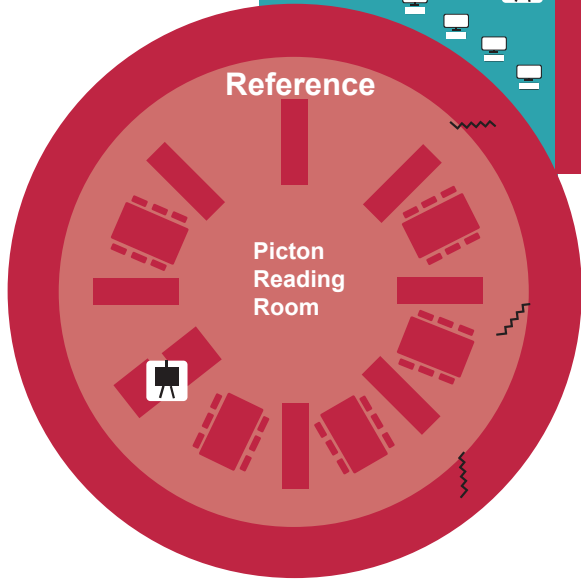
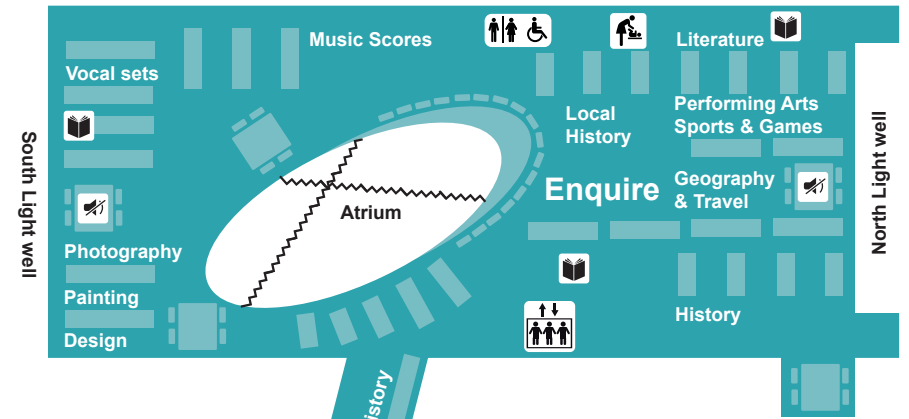
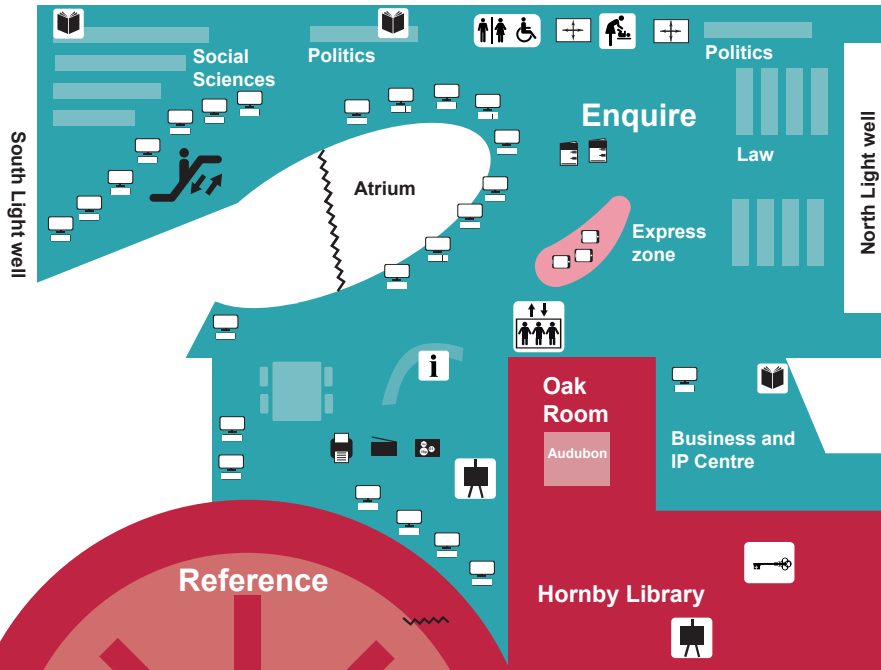
The **roof terrace** provides spectacular views across the city and beyond.

GROUND FLOOR

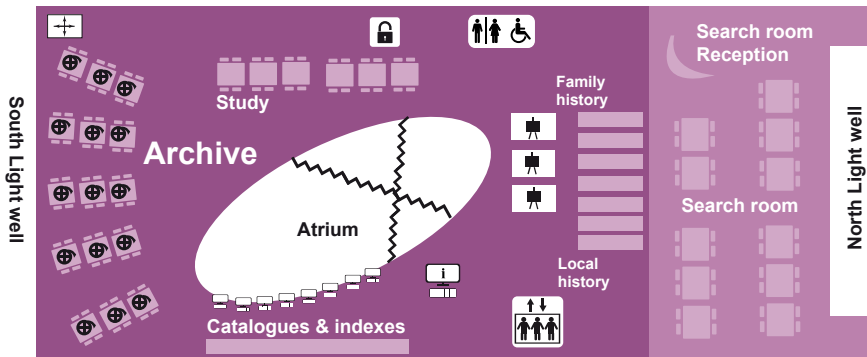

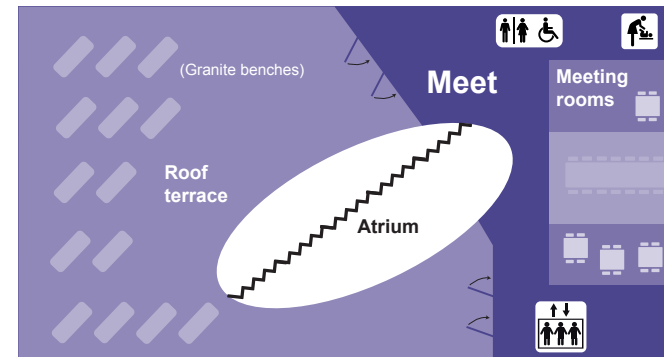

Meeting rooms for hire

Looking for the perfect venue to hire for your meeting? Our three high quality meeting rooms can be configured to suit your specific requirements.

Room facilities

- Overhead projector (laptop connection available via floor box).
- Electrically operated projector screen.
- Table to house laptop for presentations (please note: laptop not provided).
- Whiteboard and noticeboard.
- Coat stand.
- Chairs and tables.
- Mobile flipchart easels (please note: pads not provided).

Room configurations

Rooms have sound-attenuated flexible partitioning and can be booked singly, as two rooms (1 and 2 or 2 and 3) or opened up as one large room (1, 2 and 3):

- Room 1 - 33 square metres - seats 20.
- Room 2 - 53 square metres - seats 35.
- Room 3 - 23 square metres - seats 12.
- Rooms 1, 2 and 3 fully opened - 110 square metres - seats 80.

Please also enquire if you have any specific requirements for events and if you are interested in out of hours use of the rooms and/or roof terrace.

Catering can also be provided and customised to meet your needs.
